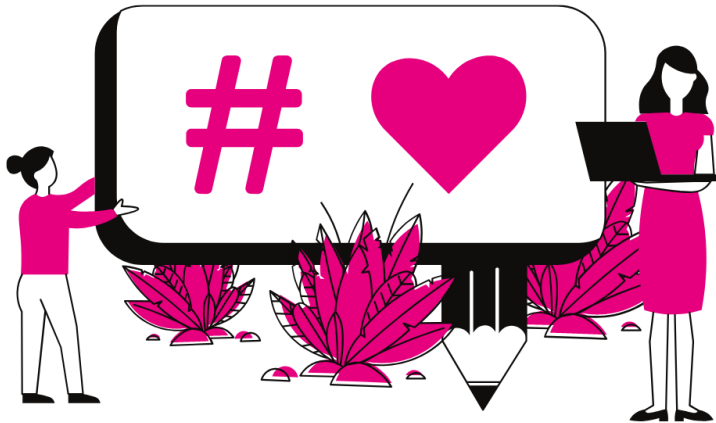


Communication is key



Fundraising is all about building relationships. During this uncertainty, it's a great time to focus on donor-centred communications, building positive experiences supporters will remember after the dust settles. This will increase their loyalty and hopefully inspire them to continue giving despite everything going on in the world.



One of the most important things you can do right now is to speak to your supporters. Be proactive, clear and transparent. It's a scary time for everyone and it's ok to be honest about that. Explain what the pandemic means for your cause in terms of delivering your key services, how you'll be looking after your beneficiaries, staff and volunteers, the impact it's having on your fundraising and how you are responding to these challenges.

Here are our top tips:

Check on your donors

Now more than ever, it's essential to take the time to get in touch with your supporters just to ask how they're doing. Let them know you're thinking of them and want to be sure they're ok during this time of uncertainty. This is a simple, free way to show your supporters that you are concerned for their health and wellbeing.

It will also open up lines of communication – they may not be in a position to help you at the moment, but when they are ready to support, they'll remember your kindness.

Give your donors practical ways to help

Lots of your supporters will want to help, but aren't always sure of the best way to contribute. Even if it doesn't directly benefit your organization financially, giving people ways to help in times of crisis builds trust and raises morale (and a lot of us probably need a little boost at the moment!).

Going digital

Being online is important now more than ever. There are lots of fantastic examples of good causes using digital techniques to enable them to continue providing as much of their services as possible. Remember, your lottery is online so a simple way for people to be able to support you while having to stay at home. Our support team is also there to help register supporters on the phone if your supporters feel more comfortable supporting that way.

There are lots of ways to keep in touch with your supporters. If you're not particularly tech savvy, spend some time testing ideas with family, friends, or co-workers to make sure you're prepared.

Look for more than just money. Your supporters may have access to items you need, even if it's their time.



Say thank you

Always follow up and say thank you. It's really important your supporters know how important they are to your cause during this time. No matter how big or small, it all makes a difference.

We've put together a short template but don't forget to make it personal and unique.
